Hill Masters

Hill Masters are individuals who have received training to operate the two rope tow lifts and agree to enforce the club procedures. Only an approved Hill Master may start the tows and a Hill Master must be present during hill operation. There are no paid lift operators or staff at SkiVenture so Hill Masters are essential to club operation. Two people must be present at all times during lift operation. Hill Master lock combinations are changed every year and given out during Hill Master training. Hill Master responsibilities are designed to comply with state regulations. Hill Masters must have prior first aid training.

Hill Master Training

Reminder – Hill Masters need to have training refreshed annually. Combination locks will be changed Training dates are Dec. 13 and Jan. 10 at 9:00 am. Once you are a Hill Master, SkiVenture is available to you 24 hours per day.

Grooming News

The 2007 -2008 season was the first year grooming with the SkiVenture groomer. The 2002 Skandic was purchased three years ago as a "box of parts" requiring both work and the purchase of a couple critical components to make it operational. We were able to locate the final part late last fall. With a couple of late nights in the barn, a bruised knuckle and a shot of starting fluid the groomer became functional.

Grooming typically takes place at the end of the week in the evening when there are no skiers in preparation for the weekend. Grooming without skiers provides both time for the snow to become firm for the following day as well as provides a much safer grooming situation.

Each time the hill is groomed there is approximately 25 miles logged in about a two hour period. Last season the groomer was out 7 times keeping the ruts in check and the surface nice.

In 2009 we plan to build a groomer building adjacent to the lower trail on the new acquired property. This building will function both as a home for the groomer and a building to store firewood. Nick Kudlacik is in the process of proposing this construction project to the Boy Scouts as his Eagle Project. If accepted construction is expected to start in late spring / early summer of 2009.

Membership Dues

The club is actively seeking new members. Annual dues continue to be very low (no increase for years) \$60.00–Family membership.

In addition, we are working on more deals: a repeat of last year's free Empire Card at Gore and Whiteface and a \$25 lift and lesson package at Belleayre Mountain. The sustaining membership cards say "season pass" on them and work at any place that gives a discount to visiting pass holders. **We will finalize benefits so check the webpage for updates**.

Volunteer's Make the Difference


